Campbellford & District Palliative Care Services “turn over the keys” to Community Care Northumberland

What: Over the summer, representatives from Palliative Care Campbellford (PCC), Hospice Northumberland Lakeshore (HNL), Community Care Northumberland (CCN) and the Central East Local Health Integration Network (CE LHIN), worked on a facilitated integration that will now see hospice services, previously provided by PCC and HNL, integrated into the group of services provided by CCN.

The Integration Plan, which was approved by the boards of the respective organizations after extensive community engagement, will provide clients and their families with easy access to a wider range of support services and ensure that local hospice services continue to be available throughout Northumberland County including Campbellford, Brighton, Cobourg, Colborne, Hastings and Port Hope.

The “turning over the keys” ceremony in Campbellford helps to mark the mid-December launch of the new Community Care Northumberland – Hospice Services as former PCC staff and volunteers and their Hospice Northumberland Lakeshore colleagues take on new roles and continue to provide vital hospice services to the residents of Northumberland County.
